

2022 Civic Election Overview for Potential Candidates

Candidate Qualifications

- ✓ Must be 18 years of age or older on General Voting Day
- ✓ Must be a Canadian citizen
- ✓ Must be a resident of BC for 6 months
- ✓ Must not be disqualified for any other reason
- Must complete and submit Nomination Package by deadline (Sep. 9 at 4:00 pm)
 - Must have appointment for City to review the package before the deadline
- Review requirements for Nominators ← they will be verified!
 - Minimum of 10 qualified nominators needed
- Candidates must be officially declared by the Chief (or Deputy Chief) Election Officer
- Must meet all Elections BC financial requirements
 - Elections BC requires appointment of financial agent, bank account, etc.

Campaign Advertising

- No advertising on General Voting Day
- · Ministry of Transportation has restrictions on signs near public roads or highways
- Candidates to review Election BC advertising rules
 - Must contain an authorization statement as of the Pre-Campaign Period (Jul. 18)
 - Must be 100 metres away from a polling place
 - 3rd Party advertising rules
 - 3rd party expense limits
 - Sponsorship contributions

Key Dates and Deadlines

Jul 18	Pre-Campaign Period Begins	When Elections BC regulations for advertising & 3 rd parties start
Aug 30	Nomination Period Begins	Nomination packages available in early August, but cannot be submitted to the City prior to 9:00 am on Aug. 30
Sep 9	Nomination Period Ends	Nomination Period ends at 4:00 pm
Sep 17	Campaign Period Begins	4:00 pm on Sep. 16 is last day to withdraw as a candidate
Sep 19	Declaration of Election by Vote or by Acclamation	Occurs at 4:00 pm
Oct 15	General Voting Day	Advance voting days and mail ballot voting opportunities will exist
Oct 19	Declaration of Official Election Results	CALL THE AMERICAN CONTRACTOR OF THE SECOND CON
Nov 1	Inaugural Council Meeting	Swearing-in ceremony and Oath of Office
